



January 27, 2026 | 9:00am - 10:30am (EST) | ZOOM Autism & Epilepsy: Seizure Recognition and First Aid Certification

This course discusses the core characteristics of autism, the co-occurrence of autism and epilepsy, and covers training in seizure recognition and seizure first aid. Upon completing the session and pre/post-knowledge assessment, participants will receive a 2-year certification in Seizure Recognition and First Aid issued by the Epilepsy Foundation of America.

February 4, 11, 18, and 25, 2026 | 9:00am - 10:30am (EST) | ZOOM Pregnancy Across Four Trimesters

This interactive training series equips home visitors, nurses, and community health workers with a comprehensive understanding of the many changes across each trimester of pregnancy, including the often-overlooked fourth trimester. Participants will gain practical tools, case-based learning, and curated resources to support expectant and new mothers confidently.

Intro to Motivational Interviewing (March 2026 - 2 Days In Person) Motivational Interviewing Refresher Course (April 2026 - 1 Day Virtually)

Motivational Interviewing is a collaborative, person-centered approach that helps strengthen a family's motivation for change. These learning opportunities, which include a two-day core training and a one-day refresher, will provide practical skill-building and real-world application for home visitors and family support professionals.

April 14, 2026 | 8:00am - 12:00pm | ZOOM Soothing the Storm: Helping Families Navigate Infant Crying"

This 4-hour training will strengthen home visitors' understanding of Shaken Baby Syndrome and the Period of PURPLE Crying while offering practical tools to help families cope with infant crying and prevent harm. Learn how to educate and support parents with empathy, clarity, and confidence.

This 4-part virtual series explores the vital role of fathers in child development and family well-being. Participants will learn strategies to overcome common barriers, practice cultural humility, and gain tools to better engage fathers in home visits. Includes a self-paced module through the Institute for the Advancement of Family Support Professional, group discussions, and applied learning with the families you currently partner with.

Goal: To develop a shared set of core competencies that reflect best practices across home visiting models. These competencies will support consistent professional development, strengthen practice, and ultimately ensure families receive high-quality support; no matter which program they are enrolled in.

Phase One

Workgroup Formation & Shared Understanding:

- Recruit a representative, cross-model workgroup
- Establish purpose, scope, norms, and expectations



Phase Two

Define Scope & Competency Domains:


- Identify what is “core” across all home visiting programs
- Align with, not replace, model-specific requirements



Phase Three

Draft Core Competencies:

- Develop knowledge, skills, and attributes by domain
- Ensure strengths-based, usable language



Phase Four

Stakeholder Review & Refinement:

- Gather feedback from programs and partners statewide
- Revise based on themes and input



Phase Five

Finalization & Recommendations:

- Finalize Delaware Core Competencies
- Share implementation recommendations and next steps
