Put it up, not down

Prescriptions, drugs, and vitamins should be put away, right away after you use them or bring them into the house.

No container is child proof

Keep prescriptions, recreational drugs, and vitamins in their original containers and invest in a lockbox for extra safety.

Make sure everyone follows the safe storage rules. Teach everyone visiting your home where and how you safely store drugs and medications.
