WHAT'S WRAP-AROUND TRAINING?

Wrap-around training literally wraps around and supplements core training provided by Home Visiting and Community Health Worker programs. Wrap-around training covers various topics, strengthening Home Visiting workforce development and advancing high-quality implementation of evidence-based Home Visiting programs throughout Delaware.

WHAT TYPE OF TRAINING OPTIONS ARE OFFERED?



Group training sessions are offered in person and online. Home Visitors and Community Health Workers conduct an annual survey to determine topics of interest. Information about group training sessions is emailed individually to potential participants and posted on the Wrap-Around Training webpage.



Online training modules are available on a wide range of topics through the Institute for the Advancement of Family Support Professionals. Online modules help Home Visitors and Community Health Workers learn new skills and grow their careers.



Reflective supervision networking meetings include participation in a bimonthly support group that provides collaboration and training opportunities for program supervisors and mentors.



Home Visitors share areas of expertise. Home Visitors have a wealth of knowledge and expertise, and they're willing to share what they know with their colleagues. Opportunities are available to shadow them on home visits; ask for skill demonstrations; or get problem-solving help in person, online, or by phone or email.
